
Advancing Renewable Energy in the Midwest

Minnesota benefits from \$6.0 billion in capital investments from wind energy. Minnesota landowners receive estimated lease payments of ~\$9 million, annually. 24 Minnesota counties benefit from more than \$12 million in Production Tax revenue.
